## Academic support

We do everything we can to help our students reach their potential.

University-style lectures teach students about areas of their subjects that they may not have encountered at school. ## Careers support

We work with a wide range of partners across London to organise K+ careers days that give our students an insight into a working world. This empowers our students to think ambitiously about their future career and gain an understanding of how they might get there.

## Expert application support

On the programme students receive tailored advice on their personal statement, preparation for admission interviews and multiple mini-interview support should they be interested in applying for Medicine or Dentistry. Students also receive up-to-date guidance on student finance.

## Summer School

One of the highlights of K+ is the Spotlight Summer School. Spotlight is a free, non-residential, week-long programme of events.

Students have small-group lessons run by a King's PhD tutors. Each tutor is a specialist in the students' chosen subject. They get tailored support from their tutor to prepare students for completing their own assessed independent academic project.

There's also taster workshops run by King's student societies and clubs, social events and challenges with other students throughout the week, and employability skills workshops from external organisations.

## Year 13 support

As students progress into Year 13, K+ helps them prepare for the transition to university. Sessions on a range of topics are offered, including study skills, taking care of your wellbeing and mental health and finding your community at university.

If you continue on to King's, the support does not stop there!

## Key benefits

If students complete K+, they will earn a 2-grade reduced offer on most of our undergraduate courses. If they attend King's as an undergraduate they'll receive a £1,000 start-up bursary and join a community of K+ alumni who receive additional support in their studies.
